God has burdened him to labor within the Chinese community here in the US as well as in the American churches. Abraham Weihua Liu and Grace Jianhua Liu studied and served among the house churches for seven years in China. They suffered much for the sake of Jesus in China, and proved the sufficiency of God's grace to sustain them and produce fruit through them in China. God miraculously brought them to the USA in 2005. On December 31, 2005, Pastor Mark and Pastor Jerry sent the Liu family to the Evangelical Institute of

Greenville, South Carolina. Abraham was instilled as the first pastor of a Chinese church in Clemson, South Carolina in 2007 through September of 2011. God is leading him to minister His word throughout the Chinese churches in the US and to assist Chinese couples in their marriages and families. 

We spent the first part of this year working on these initiatives as well as planning and conducting several workshops, a pastor's conference and continued administration of our Fiji Bible College.

I received my M.Div. in May of 2012 and will be completing my Th.M. in the Fall of 2012. I recall this time at this seminary as one of his sweetest experiences even though it was packed with rigorous academic training. I am grateful to the Lord for directing my steps to a seminary that is serious about training men as if lives depended on it! Now that the training is almost over, my family and I are preparing to return to Fiji within the year and rejoin the faculty of the Fiji Bible College from which I graduated years ago. My desire is to train the next generation of young men for ministry in the South Pacific region. This Bible College has been training pastors for the past 38 years under the leadership of Dr. Narayan Nair.

I am blessed to preach at the Salvation Army Church on the last Sunday of this month and conduct Bible studies as I travel to villages as well as broadcast a radio program every Thursday. Joseph Tan, Southeast Asia: Esther and I have found ourselves running full steam ahead throughout Southeast Asia this first half of the year! I am blessed to have been able to preach, teach, lead and facilitate seminars and spread God's word in throughout India, Vietnam, the Philippines, Indonesia and on many of the surrounding islands in the midst of major illness, car-jackings, power outages, soaring temperatures and heat exhaustion, gun fights, car and bus crashes, drought, famine and everything else satan has used to try to stop us! By the grace of God, we have reached all of our destinations for divine appointments with these native people who hunger for His Word and His presence.



Cathy Kreis: The first of the year was spent traveling from Atlanta at our annual Staff conference to the west visiting with ministry supporters and family. I have also spent much time and resources preparing for a great mission trip in August to the Navajo nation. It will be a blessed time serving and witnessing to this nation in Shiprock AZ. God has amazed me in His provision of housing, supplies, food and funds as well as our team in this mission.

I am also still preaching and teaching in our county jail where the Lord has me every week.



Chris Mohan, India: We thank the Lord for opening doors for utterance in several Churches in and around Bangalore on a regular basis. Some churches are outreach ones and others are well established. These provide various opportunities for systematic teaching of the word, counseling, youth gatherings, discussions on current issues facing churches etc. Praise be to God for being selected as one of 3 ministers world-wide by the Academy for Church Planting & Leadership in Bangalore to be given an honorary Doctorate of Divinity Degree.



Stan Hankins: Abundant fruit is born as I have opportunity to plant and nurture gospel growth in men and women near and far. Preaching and teaching, I recently proclaimed Christ on both coasts and in between. Internationally thus far this year, I have taught at a Theological College in the South Seas and trained indigenous pastors in Africa. Those pastors were some of the most enthusiastic and engaged whom I have encountered the world over. Upcoming months invest in young church planters in India who will penetrate closed countries with the message. Central America promises empowering local pastors and preaching meetings. The year concludes in Thailand, training missionaries who will share the love of God with the multitudes in Asia.

The United States will not be overlooked. Spiritual Renewal Preaching Series await in three churches in two states when autumn leaves turn.

That's the plan and platform for ministry. The pattern originates from our Lord who said, "The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."



Harold Brown: In our older age, we are grateful for continuing blessings to minister to those in 'assisted living' at the nursing home here. Anna assists me when I cannot physically meet the ministry demands. We continue to reach out to the lost people who go to the weekly auction here in town. God is at work in hearts and we want to be just the kind of channels God wants us to be there. Some people there are having serious physical needs and we need the help of the Lord to reach out to them in the Name of Jesus. That's the main reason we go to the auction.

The Lord has been bringing some people to our house from time to time to time and we need prayer that we will be open to speak of the Christian way with them and perhaps something from the Bible.



Luke Johnson: Much of the first half of the year has centered on my mission trip to India, where I traveled to the state of Himachal Pradesh in North India. It is one of the most unreached places in India. We trekked in to villages where the Gospel has never been before. In 20-25 villages, I met 5 people who had ever heard the Name of Jesus. We made first Gospel contact and left Gospel tracts and some Bibles in the villages. Our national brother is going through these unreached places sharing the Gospel (in over 300 villages) and currently has planted 2 house churches. The work is slow but steady, and he is starting to see some of the first fruits of the Harvest coming in after 7 years of labor. He is actively discipling these new believers, and 5 are going for Gospel training the next 2 weeks. Glory to God!



Tony Van Dyke: God has led me to so many places this first half of the year. I am excited to be a new part of Ambassadors For Christ and to take His name and preach His Word to places like college campuses, homeless shelters, many youth classes and organizations, my local community and in local prisons around Georgia.
